## How to Begin Using Media in Worship

**Rev. Dr. Tim Coombs:** A pastor, media expert and storyteller, Rev. Coombs serves on the Board of Directors of national Network of Biblical Storytellers as its “digital guru”, as Contract Staff for Congregational Health and Transformation for Albany Presbytery, and co-pastor with his wife of Trinity Presbyterian Church, Scotia, NY. He has introduced countless churches to the use of media in worship.

## Biblical Storytelling in Worship

**Rev. John Klatt:** pastor of St. John’s Lutheran Church in West Seneca, is co-founder of the Western New York Guild. He has served congregations in Frewsburg, Herkimer, Redwood and Hamburg, N.Y. He tries to “tell” the Gospel story as often as possible during worship services.
